BURBANK ELEMENTARY (K-6)

Assessment Summary:

Burbank Elementary School is a well laid out campus with an adequately sized playground and field but a very limited staff parking area which is entered and exited from a single driveway on Allen. School facilities are comprised of the original 1929 buildings on its southern end and vintage 1970s classroom and administration facilities on the north end of campus. The kindergarten complex lies on the south-east end and is accessible for student drop-off and pick-up from Minoru Drive. Remaining grades students use Allen as a drop-off and pick-up zone.

Identified immediate needs are the modernization of the Cafeteria and Kitchen areas, spaces which, in most cases, were not addressed district-wide under the previous modernization program. Other recommended repairs include the upgrading of the electrical, lighting, and plumbing infrastructure.

The master planning effort has recommended expansion of the parking area towards the existing field while concurrently reclaiming lost field area through expansion of the field on its south end. Also, in keeping with the district's goal of portable building-free campuses, replacement of these by construction of a five-classroom permanent building south of the lunch shelter where present portables are located.
